Dinner is at 6:30pm at the lodge, and our first session will be in the Program Center and start at 7:30pm But don't worry - even if you're late, we'll have plenty of food ready for you!

Remember that Sunday morning is always a big deal as it's the closing out of the Retreat. There will be a full breakfast and a really exciting service with a great message, so make sure you plan to stay with us until we're all wrapped up at 11:30.

What to bring:

Whether you're staying in the Lodge or camping, we'll be all together, so when you arrive, follow signs to Lodge. If you are staying inside, come inside and find a bunk. If you are camping, there are carts available at the parking lot to move your gear out behind the lodge where you'll be staying. **DO NOT DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE BEYOND THE PARKING LOT.** The Lodge is very close to the Program Center where we will have all of our worship and teachings. *Most of our meals will be happening in the lodge this year* (this is different from previous years).

If you stay in the lodge, you will be in a bunk room with a mattress provided. You will still need to bring your own sleeping bag/blanket and pillow. If you are camping, please remember that you do need to bring your own camping gear. You can set up your camping gear in the designated area behind the lodge, but be careful that you don't get too close to the camp fire!

How to get to Riverside Retreat Center from Cape Coral: 7305 County Road 78, LaBelle, FL 33935

Some of the GPS systems have trouble sorting that address out, so please check your phone/device ahead of time. You can also follow these step by step directions from the Cape:

From Cape Coral follow Pine Island Rd. East towards N. Ft. Myers.

Pine Island Rd will dead end into FL-31, turn left.

Turn right onto FL-78/N. River Road.

Stay on this road for 15.2 miles and Riverside will be on your right.
